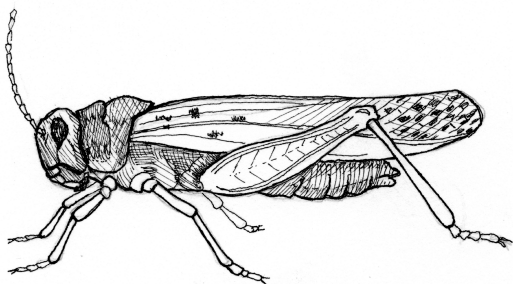

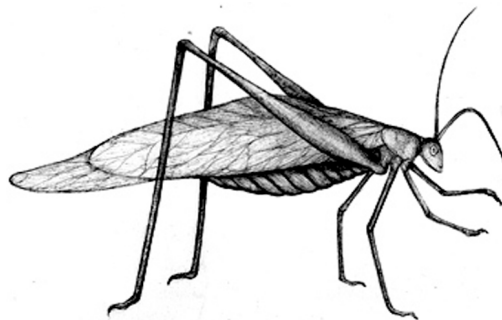
Grasshoppers of the Twin Cities

(found on dry open ground – has black wings – 3 inches long)

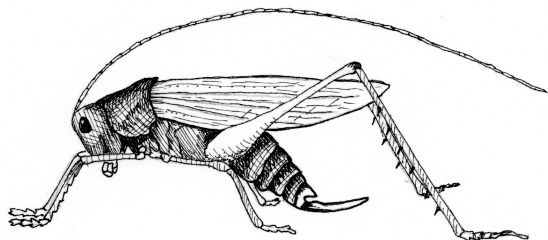

(Found in bushes and tall grass – looks like a leaf – 3 inches long)

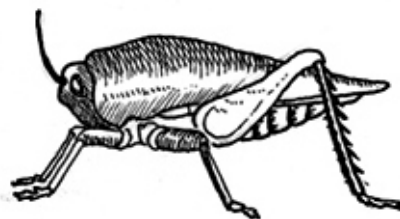

(found in tall marsh grass – makes buzzing sound – 2 inches long)

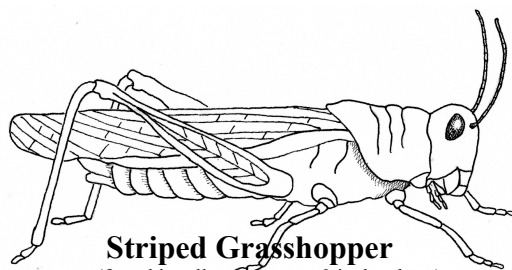

(found in un-mowed short grass – lives two years – smallest hopper)

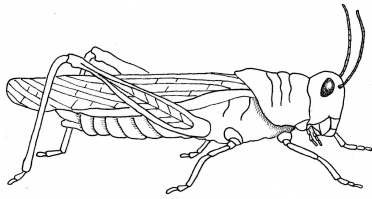

Striped Grasshopper

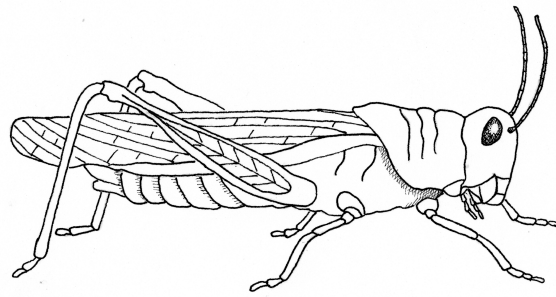
(found in tall marsh grass-3 inches long)

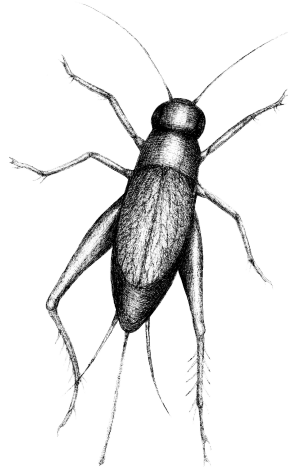
Red-legged Grasshopper

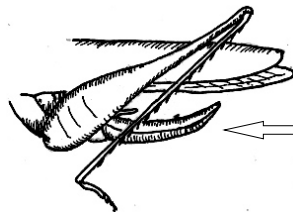
