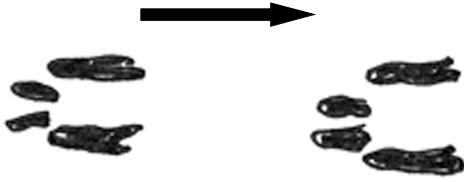


Animal Tracks

Hoppers



Squirrel – Clumps of 4 tracks. Tracks often go to a tree. At least 2 feet between hops



Rabbit - Clump of 4 tracks. At least 2 feet between each clump.

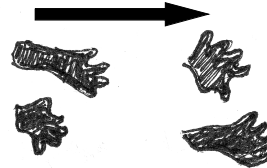


Mouse – Small clumps of tracks. Each clump 4 inches apart. Tail drag between clumps.

Walkers



Deer –hind foot steps in the front foot track. Have hooves



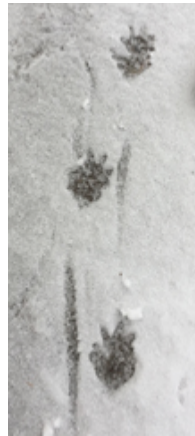
Raccoon – Hind foot is larger than the front foot. Usually not active unless it is at least 30° F



Fox – hind foot steps in the front foot track. The pad and toes similar to a dog.



Dog- hind foot does not step in the front foot. Leaves a sloppy pattern.



Possum – distinct toes and tail drag
